Lesson - September 17

1. The Romans and Greeks at the time of the writing of the book of Ephesians worshipped multiple gods and goddesses which they manipulated to give them that they thought they wanted – power, money, pleasure, prestige, and so forth. What do we worship in America today? What are our false gods? Are Christians guilty of having false gods? Are we ever guilty of trying to manipulate the Lord God Almighty?
2. Look at Acts 19:21 – 20:1. Much of the impact of Christianity was the result of other believers sharing the gospel. Discuss this phenomenon. How can/should we apply this principle today? What should be our response?
3. Read Acts 20:30 Men were already beginning to distort the truth. What is our responsibility and challenge today to guard the truth of the gospel?
4. Read Revelation 2: 1 – 7 For what was the church at Ephesus commended? What were they called to change? What lessons does this provide for the church/Christians today?
