Head of gold: Babylon (66 years: 605 – 539 BC) Chest and Arms of silver: Medes and Persians (208 years: 539–331 bc) Middle and Thighs of bronze: Greece (185 years: 331 – 146 BC) Legs of iron: Rome (about 500 years as a unified empire, 27 BC – 1453 AD in total) Feet of iron and clay: End times world power (ten horns of Rev 13:10; 17:12)
