

Three questions.

I. What does "firstborn" mean?

Think of <u>honor</u>, not birth order.

II. What "world" is referred to in this verse?

The whole world is His, but the primary emphasis is probably the angels in <u>heaven</u> bowing in worship at Jesus' <u>enthronement</u> at the right hand of the Father.

III. Where does this quote come from?

In both Deuteronomy 32 and Ps 97, Yahweh is the subject. Now these verses are applied to Jesus. Jesus is <u>God</u>!

One command: Worship Him!

What does worship of Jesus look like?

- 1. Definition: to bow down, to prostrate oneself, even kissing the ground at His feet.
- 2. Keep His word. John 14:21
- 3. Tell others about Him. In Matthew 28 Jesus commissioned them to go.
