March 25 (Sat) – Riverdance at the Fox

The incredible dancing of the Irish will take center stage at the Fox Theater in Detroit. We will enjoy the spectacular dancing from prime seats. (\$80) **Registration closed**.

April 20 (Thurs) - Zehnder's Ragtime Festival
